It enables them to understand the hitherto unknown family and school dynamics and develop strategies for changing emotions and behaviours. The result helps to create a positive and generative atmosphere amongst families and in the classroom. And for children and young adults to engage more effectively in learning and creativity.

Marianne has taught in both primary and secondary schools for over 28 years. She has also worked as an independent holistic, psychotherapy practitioner in Munich since 1990. Originally trained with Bert Hellinger in the early eighties, she has pioneered the use of a systemic perspective in education internationally. A member of the Wieslocher Institute for Systemic Solutions, she facilitates family constellation workshops, works with young people and trains teachers and therapists in systemic working. She has written a book about her work called 'You're One of Us. Systemic insights and solutions for Teachers, Students and Parents.
